#### I. READING COMPREHENSION

The project started well, but when it was only a few months underway, a tragic accident on the site took the life of John Roebling. Washington was injured and left with brain damage, unable to talk or walk. Nonetheless, he still had a burning desire to complete the bridge. - As Washington lay in his hospital room, a gentle breeze blew the flimsy curtains apart and he was able to see the sky for just a moment. It seemed that there was a message for him not to give up. Suddenly, an idea hit him. All he could do was move one finger, and he decided to make the best use of it. He slowly developed a code of communication with his wife. He touched his wife's arm with that finger, indicating to her that he wanted her to call the engineers again. Then, he used the same code to tell the engineers what to do until the bridge was finally completed. Today, the spectacular Brooklyn Bridge stands in all its glory as a tribute to the triumph of one man's indomitable spirit and his determination not to be defeated by circumstances.
